REJECT LIES AND EMBRACE TRUTH

1. Reject Anger and Embrace Forgiveness:

Be angry, and do not sin: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.
Ephesians 4:26-27

2. Reject Worry and Embrace Trust:

“Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?”
Matthew 6:25-26

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything (how) by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

3. Reject Pride and Embrace Humility:

Fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. 4. Reject Fear and Embrace Faith:

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

5. Reject Lust and Embrace Purity:

“But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.”
Matthew 5:28

6. Reject Bitterness and Embrace Forgiveness:

Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

7. Reject Selfishness and Embrace Generosity:

Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share.

8. Reject Gossip and Embrace Edification:

Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

9. Reject Unbelief and Embrace Faith:
