Logos and Rhema

Logos and Rhema

Lógos principally refers to the totality of the inspired Word of God and also to Jesus.

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In the beginning was the Word (*lógos*), and the Word (*lógos*) was with God, and the Word (*lógos*) was God.

John 1:1

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Lógos refers to not only God's Word, but also Christ Himself.

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For the word (*lógos*) of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Hebrews 4:12

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Then Mary said, “Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word (*rhéma*).”
And the angel departed from her.

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Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judea... while Annas and Caiaphas were high priests, the word (*rhéma*) of God came to John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.
