# Salvation and Sanctification

Salvation is the deliverance, by the grace of God, from eternal punishment for sin which is granted to those who accept by faith God's conditions of repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus.

Salvation is available in Jesus alone and is dependent on God alone for provision, assurance, and security.

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The setting apart of something for special use; to “sanctify” a person is to make him holy.

The word means consecration, purification, and separation unto God.

# Salvation and Sanctification

Sanctification refers not only to the activity of the Holy Spirit in setting man apart unto salvation and transferring him into the ranks of the redeemed, but also to enabling him to be holy even as God is holy.
