The doctrine of the trinity can be defined as:

Father, Son and Spirit

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The doctrine of the trinity can be defined as:

“God eternally exists as three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and each person is fully God, and there is one God.”

Father, Son and Spirit

What is the trinity?

Which means that, as God, God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit are also eternal, omnipresent, omnipotent, infinitely wise, infinitely holy, infinitely loving, omniscient, and so forth.

Each has all the attributes we ascribe to God.

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In Creation:

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Father, Son and Spirit

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

Then God said, "Let there be light";
and there was light.

Genesis 1:1-3

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Father, Son and Spirit

In the beginning was the Word (Son), and the Word (Son) was with God, and the Word (Son) was God.

He (Son) was in the beginning with God.

All things were made through Him (Son), and without Him (Son) nothing was made that was made.

John 1:1-3

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For by Him (Son) all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him (Son) and for Him (Son).

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Father, Son and Spirit

In Redemption:

God the Father planned redemption and sent His Son into the world for that purpose (John 3:16-17).

God the Son obeyed the Father and accomplished redemption for us (John 6:37-39, Heb. 10:5-7).

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The Holy Spirit seems to bring to completion the work that has been planned by the Father and begun by God the Son.

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There are diversities (divisions, distributions, distinctions, differences, classifications or separations) of gifts (*charisma* – to show favor, a gift of grace imparted from God, an undeserved benefit), but the same Spirit (Holy Spirit).

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There are differences of ministries,
but the same Lord.

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There are differences (divisions, distributions, distinctions, diversities, classifications or separations) of ministries (*diakonia* – service or serving, those who execute the commands of another, administration, the office of ministering in divine things), but the same Lord (Jesus Christ).
